Early Childhood Education

The Early Childhood Education Center at Caroline Mission provides services on a sliding scale and include an individualized education plan for each child with a focus on parent involvement.

After School

UP After School provides services for elementary-aged students in primarily low-income neighborhoods. Serving 12 school sites in 2021, after school programming continued to adapt to the changing educational landscape.

Summer Enrichment

UP offers Summer Enrichment camps at locations throughout St. Louis City and Count. In 2021, we were able to return to in-person camp with *seven* camp locations.

Mission and Vision




